## GENERAL RULES FOR ALL COMPETITIONS:

**1. Eligibility:** Open to participants of all age groups. Participants can compete in one of the following categories:

**2. Registration:** All participants must register through the official form/link before the deadline. No entries will be accepted without registration.

**3. Originality:** Artwork must be original and created by the participant. Copied, traced, or AI-generated art will be disqualified.

**4. Medium:** Participants may use any of the following mediums:

Pencil, Crayons, Oil Pastels, Watercolors, Acrylics, Digital Drawing (optional category – must mention clearly).

**5. Size:** Artwork must be made on an A4 or A3 size sheet (or corresponding digital canvas).

#### 1. Photos/Files Required:

- A clear photo or scanned copy of the completed drawing.
- One photo of the participant with the artwork (for authenticity).
- Optional: Time-lapse or short video while drawing (15–30 seconds).

**2. File Format:** JPG, PNG, or MP4 (video); maximum file size: 10 MB.

**3. Submission Mode:** Upload via the provided form/link or email to [sparshart@gmail.com](mailto:sparshart@gmail.com).

**4. Late Entries:** Submissions after the deadline will not be considered.

## GENERAL RULES FOR ALL COMPETITIONS:

  - b) One photo showing the participant making the Rangoli (for authenticity).
  - c) *Optional*: A time-lapse or short video (15–30 seconds) during the creation.
2. **File Format**: JPG, PNG, or MP4 (video); Max file size: 10 MB.
3. **Submission Mode**: Upload via the official link/form or email to [sparshart@gmail.com].
4. **Late Entries**: Submissions after the deadline will not be entertained.

**4. Medium:** **Only natural Mehendi (Henna)** should be used. No black henna, stickers, or artificial coloring is allowed.

- a) Must apply on hand/feet/body part shown. Designs must be freehand (no stencils).
- b) Participants can draw on their own hand or someone else's.
- c) You can hold a "Timed Challenge" — e.g., design within 45 minutes live on a Zoom call.
- d) Bonus Points: For intricacy, neatness, and creativity.

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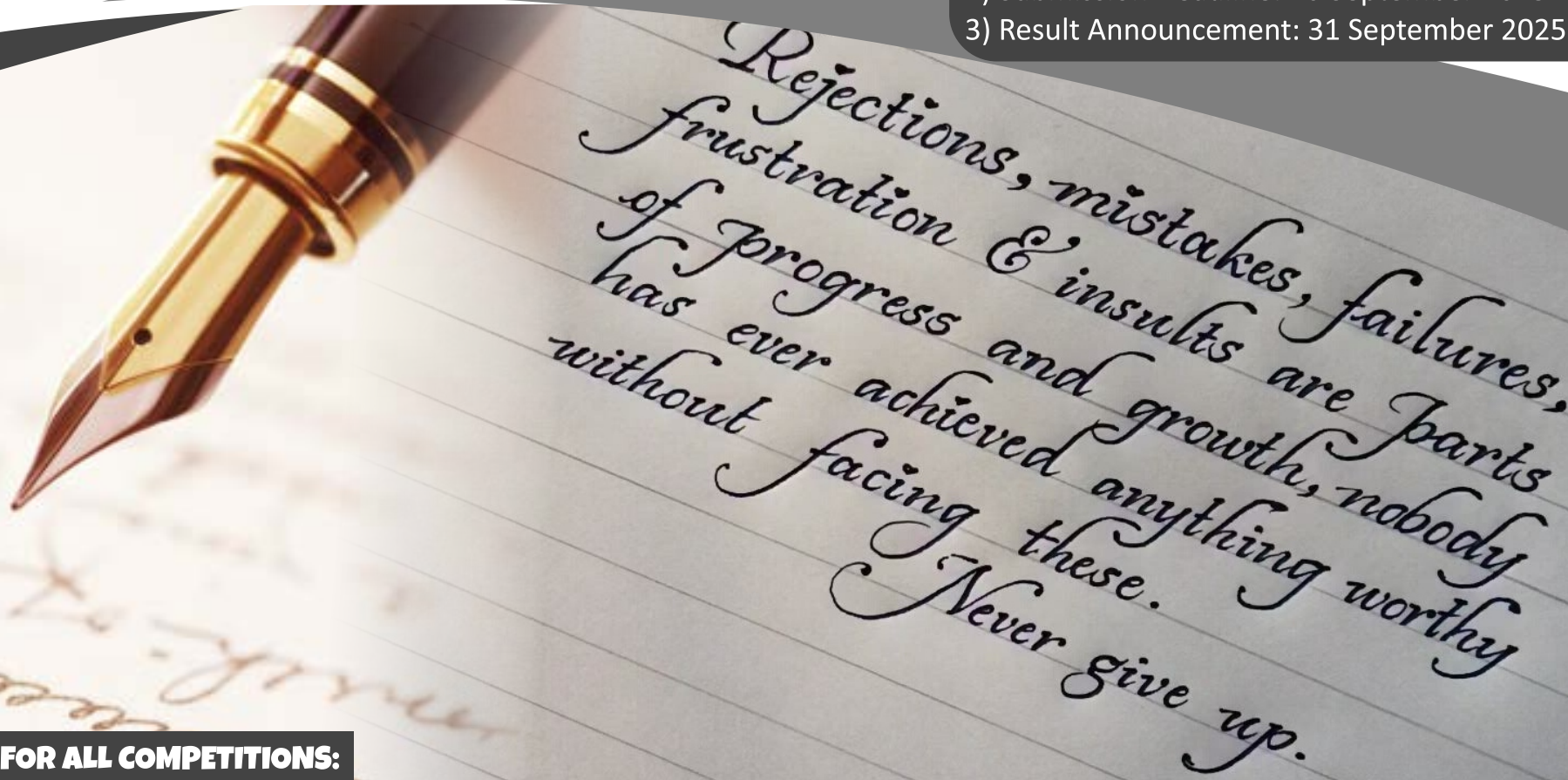


# ONLINE HANDWRITING COMPETITION

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## GENERAL RULES FOR ALL COMPETITIONS:

**1. Eligibility:** Open to participants of all age groups. Participants can compete in one of the following categories:

Senior	XII & Above
Adult	Open

**2. Registration:** Participants must register through the official form/link before the deadline. Unregistered entries will not be accepted.

**3. Originality:** The handwriting must be entirely the participant's own. Typed or traced entries will be disqualified.

**4. Medium:** Handwriting must be done with pen or pencil on plain or ruled paper. Decorative borders or illustrations are optional.

**5. Language & Content:** Participants may write a given paragraph or choose their own. Content must be decent and non-political.

**6. Length:** Minimum 8 lines, maximum 20 lines. Must fit on a single A4 sheet.

## 7. Writing material:

1. Only blue/black ink pens (or as instructed).
2. Paper: White ruled or plain sheet.
3. No use of calligraphy tools unless the competition specifies "calligraphy".
4. Categories: Cursive Writing, Print Writing, Calligraphy.

3. "Poem: 'My Mother'"
